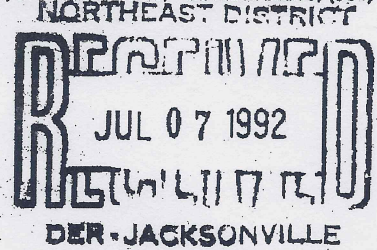


This letter is in response to our telephone conversations regarding the proposed STEP tanks in Greenridge II subdivision, St. Johns County.

You asked for the following clarifications:

1. Jacksonville Suburban Utilities will own and operate the STEP tanks and all downstream piping. The customer is only responsible from the house to the STEP tank.
2. Each STEP tank will provide at least 50 gallons of storage volume above the high level alarm.
